- 2. Have you ever been surprised to find that somebody you have known has got a particular job?

Read Mark 6:1-6a

- 3. In verse 2 the people were 'astounded'. What were they astounded at?
- 4. In verse 3 the people 'took offence'. Why?
- 5. In what ways are people astounded or offended by Jesus today?
- 6. How easy or difficult do you find it to talk with your family or closest friends about your faith?
- 7. Why couldn't Jesus generally perform miracles in that environment? Why did he still heal some people?
- 8. Read Luke 7:9. Jesus is only described as being amazed twice in the gospels. In Mark 6:6 and Luke 7:9. What is the same? What is different?

Read Mark 6:6b-13

- 9. What does this passage teach you about faith?
- 10. What two-pronged ministry are the disciples engaged in (v12-13)?
- 11. How should the disciples deal with unbelief?
- 12. What can we learn from this passage about how we are to live out our lives?

Prayer Points

- 1. Pray that we will be able to share Jesus with those who know us well.
- 2. Pray for those who think they know who Jesus is. Pray they will encounter the real Jesus.
- 3. Pray for the work of St George's and St Martin's. Pray that we will trust in Jesus and not in programmes or resources.
- 4. Pray that we will proclaim the Gospel clearly.
- 5. Pray for courage and strength when people reject us because we follow Jesus.
